


#### SUBTLE NATURE

#### Curator Conchi Álvarez

This is the second solo exhibition of Annabel Overbury's work at the STOA Gallery. Annabel is a British artist who has been living in Estepona for many years. Intimate and personalised landscapes, together with her delicate flower paintings, are the most prominent genres in Annabel's artistic production. This is not surprising considering the British roots of her art education, overlaid with her fascination with Mediterranean light. If we take into consideration her lifelong commitment to environmentalism and her love of the natural environment, we have a fairly accurate idea of Annabel's art.


The exhibition comprises 42 medium and small format works with a common theme: landscape and flowers. Watercolours predominate. This is the artist's favourite technique, and her use of the medium with flowing brush strokes is masterful. She has also introduced a new mixed-media technique where tissue paper is the main element. The support for watercolour is usually paper, but she also uses cotton and linen canvases for other media. Annabel's analytical studies and sketches could become larger format works in the future or remain as they are with the superb freshness found in the watercolour washes.

Annabel's landscapes belong within the tradition known as European "plein air" painting for she has a passion for painting outdoors. The artist's working method involves precisely that - going out into the countryside and, when a subject inspires her, she settles down to work under its spell, in communion with the energy of Nature that is reflected in her work. This approach requires a deep understanding of all the elements which, in the case of this artist, are complex. Despite the apparent simplicity of her paintings, each composition transmits sounds, rhythms and tempo as well as the suggestions, cadences and rhymes of the underlying narrative. The result is a delightful overture of Nature. The deconstruction of the individual elements of these "Annabelian operas" is followed by a syncretic phase marked by complex conceptualisation where her "less is more" approach is established without losing the integrity of each work.

Part of that process takes place in the monastic space of the studio, a sacred place for every artist, a sanctum where, far from the eyes of the uninitiated, "pictorial substantiation" takes place. The real miracle of turning pigments and binders into quasi-divine materials occurs when Anna works her alchemy of turning the raw materials of acrylics, watercolours, inks and pigments into what we might call "Annabelian mixed techniques" where another element is tissue paper, gently laid down, masterfully juxtaposed or finely folded or crumpled on paper or canvas.


Not for Annabel the strident denunciation of environmental degradation. No, hers is the banner of subtlety. Undoubtedly the term "subtle" acquires its full meaning in Annabel's art. The Nature she describes and exalts is, on the one hand, delicate, soft and full of tenderness, but, at the same time, it seems enveloped by a veil of ingenuity, born of her sharp and perceptive vision.


The viewer is captivated by the lyricism, pictorial environmentalism and the sound of water which lie at the heart of these landscapes, but they are also true "symphonic poems" in which the mark making interprets a score where the elements of the landscape are anthropomorphic beings who speak, converse, sing and dance ever modulated by the serenity, emotional depth and elegance that are a reflection of Annabel herself. These are self-portraits of the soul, for there is much of Annabel in these luminous harmonies.





EVENING COLOURS Acrylic on canvas. 65 x 81 cm


WOODLAND COLOURS






IMAGINARY LANDSCAPE Mixed media on paper. 28,5 x 36,5 cm








CABRIOLE Acrylic on canvas. 46 x 55 cm


COLOUR STUDY FOR LARGE PAINTING Acrylic on paper 45 x 32,5 cm







PRIMAL WATERS Mixed media on paper. 47 x 35 cm
























